

OMR COVID-19 Mission Checklist

- Wash your hands/use hand sanitizer immediately upon entering the Fire Hall.
- Maintain physical distancing from others at Fire Hall, as practical.
- Review the OMR website for the most recent OMR COVID-19 procedures and guidance.
- Prior to entering the Fire Hall, cover your nose and mouth with an appropriate face covering. The type of face covering (medical, non-medical, cloth, etc) depends on the specific situation and risk factors.
- All team members avoid touching face while working.
- Verify you have proper PPE in the vehicle for all team members and subject(s).
- Maintain physical distancing when preparing for the mission at the Fire Hall, as well as unloading equipment, on trail, and while with Reporting Party and/or subject(s). Use proper PPE and minimize touching others, to the extent possible, during the mission.
- Use hand sanitizer upon entering the vehicle and cover your nose and mouth with a face covering when in vehicles with more than one person. Maintain good airflow and ventilation in the vehicle while traveling. In most cases, only one person will be in a team vehicle at a time. Team members may be asked to drive their personal vehicle to the trailhead to meet the team vehicles.
- If IC has advised team that subject is suspected of having COVID-19, team puts on appropriate PPE before entering the scene.
- Maintain physical distance (minimum of 6-8 feet) from individuals/groups with subject(s).
- If team has no information about potential COVID-19 (or suspects infection), have ONE person conduct the initial assessment from a 6-8 feet distance, if possible. Ensure team members are wearing proper PPE. Contact with subject should be minimized to extent possible until subject is wearing a facemask. Potential question to ask (based on mission profile) may include:
 - How do you feel; are you sick?
 - Have you been exposed to or have COVID-19?
 - Have you been tested for COVID-19?
- ONE team member approach the subject (if practicable) to give subject PPE. If subject is able to put on PPE allow subject to do so, while being supervised by OMR member. If unable to do so, ONE team member put PPE on the subject. Exercise caution if subject requires packaging. PPE (as required):
 - Mask
 - Eye protection (goggles)
 - Gloves

- Communicate with IC regarding subject's status. If signs/symptoms of COVID-19 are a possibility immediately notify command. IC will communicate info to proper parties.
- Attempt to maintain physical distancing while extricating from field. Use extra caution if litter or close proximity operations are required. Team members near subject or others must use appropriate PPE (face masks are critical).
- Upon return to Fire Hall remove PPE, if used. Dispose all PPE materials in outside dumpster.
- Immediately wash hands with soap and water upon entering Fire Hall.
- Wipe down truck - inside and out with isopropyl alcohol (or bleach solution, if alcohol is not available). Use WDOH guidance.
- Mix a new 10% bleach solution spray bottle at the time of use; do not use "old" bottles of bleach solution (may be ineffective as it degrades over time).
- Wipe down any equipment used with bleach solution, except climbing equipment and equipment that might be damaged by chemicals (ropes/webbing).
- Wash hands with soap and water upon completion/as you depart Fire Hall.
- Consider washing clothes and showering upon return to home (prior to any family interaction).
